OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject : - **Procedure for making appointment on ad-hoc/officiating/contract basis.**

No. AR-79/09/920.—A comprehensive procedures for making ad-hoc/officiating/contractual appointment was issued vide Government office memorandum No. OM-8/97 dated 29.4.2000 and subsequently another office memorandum was issued for resorting to ad-hoc/officiating/contractual appointment vide No. AR-75/2007 dated 20.8.08.

The State Government has reviewed its decision contained in the Office memorandum No. AR-75/2007 dated 20.8.08 while resorting to **ad-hoc/officiating/contract appointment on exceptional and extreme administrative exigency with a condition that the service of the candidates selected for ad-hoc/officiating/contractual appointment shall not be regularized and for regularization of their services they must go through regular procedure of direct appointment.**

In this connection, the Department of Law and Judicial was consulted for making amendment in the respective Recruitment/Service Rules and Common Examination Schemes and they have opined that in view of above cabinet decision, no further examination of the matter appears to be necessary.

Therefore, all the Ministries/Departments/Offices/Appointing Authorities under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh are hereby impressed upon to strictly follow the aforementioned decision of the Government while resorting to making ad-hoc/officiating/contractual appointment on extreme administrative exigencies. In case of exigencies also Ministry/Department/Office/Appointing Authority shall not make departure from the provisions of the Recruitment Rules/Service Rules so far as the provisions of educational qualification/written test etc., are concerned to fill up the vacancies.

The above decision of the Government is brought to the notice of all Ministries/Departments/Offices/Appointing Authorities for strict compliance.
