Dear Mr. Sharma,

As you are aware, the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has been entrusted with the responsibility of implementing the various phases of National Highways Development Project (NHDP) in various parts of the country including North Eastern States and Special Accelerated Road Development Project(SARDP) exclusively for the North Eastern Region.

2. NHAI has to implement the above NHDP/SARDP-NE programmes in a time bound manner which includes preparation of Detailed Project Reports (DPRs), pre-construction activities like land acquisition, shifting of utilities, environment and other clearances, bid preparation, evaluation of bids, award of contracts, its implementation and subsequent operation & maintenance. In order to closely supervise and complete the mandated task in a time bound manner and to maintain quality, NHAI is recruiting experienced officers primarily on deputation basis, through open advertisement, from State PWDs and various organizations dealing with roads.

3. In the recent past, advertisements were published for recruitment to various technical posts such as General Manager (Tech), Deputy General Manager (Tech), Manager (Tech) on deputation basis. However, it has been observed that response from your State PWD in deputing officer has not been very encouraging.

4. In this context, may I request you to kindly look into the matter and spare a few experienced officers for deputation to NHAI on the posts of General Manager (Tech), Dy. General Manager (Tech) and Manager (Tech) who could be assigned the projects being handled by NHAI in the North Eastern Region. In this regard, the eligibility criteria for the posts of GM/DGM/Manager, applicable to PWD officers, for deputation appointments in NHAI are enclosed for reference.

GENERAL MANAGER (TECH)

Educational Qualifications:

Essential

Degree in Civil Engineering from a reputed institution of Technology or a recognized university.

Desirable

Post Graduate Degree in Civil Engineering in the field(s) relating to Highway Engineering and/or Post Graduation Degree in Management/MBA from an institute of repute.

Experience

Essential

For officers of State PWDs:

- a). Officer should have completed 20 years service in the level of AE and above.
- b). The officer should have worked for at least 10 years as Executive Engineer on regular basis; and
- c). The officer should have put in at least 10 years experience in Highways/Roads/Bridges during his career.

Desirable

Should be well versed in the field of highway/bridge engineering/dealing with planning, pre-qualification of consultants and contractors, financial appraisal of projects, detailed designing, techno financial reviews, evaluation of tenders; contract management monitoring liaison with major construction agencies/government bodies performance appraisal of major highways/bridge projects.
