The function of the State Hazard Safety Cell shall be as follows:-

1. The Hazard Safety Cell would be established for the proper implementation of building codes in all future construction and to ensure the safety of building and structure in the future occurrence of Hazards like earthquake / floods / landslides / cyclones etc.
2. The Hazard Safety Cell would ensure enforcement of building-by-laws, creation of frame work to conduct training for Engineers/Architects and certification of these trainings.
3. To achieve competence in Hazard Resistant Design of buildings and structures as well as Restoration & Retrofitting of buildings and structures through training, acquisition of published books and documents, building codes, guidelines and manuals, documentaries and films etc. on the subject of disasters.
4. To become competent in reviewing the architectural and structural designs of all RCC, steel and Masonry Buildings and Structures from the point of view of safety under earthquakes, cyclones, floods, landslides and fire, and to prepare checklists for quick review of the new designs to adopted for buildings and structures to be constructed in the State.

5. Carry out review of all Govt. Buildings of various departments including Panchayats, and standard of type Designs etc., including review of building configuration, basic design factors adopted, in compliance with BIS codes, and reinforcing as per detailed checklist prepared.
6. To provide suitable guidelines for regulatory authorities in local bodies who carry out the initial screening of designs.
7. To act as advisory body to the State Govt. on the different aspects of building safety against hazards.
8. To act as a consultant to the State Government for retrofitting of Govt. buildings and lifeline structures.
